Meeting called to order at 7:00pm.

Minutes:

OLD BUSINESS:

Amateur Radios at Hospitals Grant:

John and Bob completed installation of the antennas at both Andalusia Regional and Mizell Memorial Hospitals. Radios were tested and the Icom IC-2820 was programmed with the frequency set used for the EOC radio.

There was some discussion about the old hospital radios that used 155.340 as a network frequency. Neither the Opp nor Andalusia Hospitals utilize this frequency at the current time.

Bob and John donated \$200 of what we received to install these antennas to both the SARC and the OARC.

Severe Weather Spotter (SKYWARN) Class:

The Basic Weather Spotter class held in October was discussed. There are plans to have an Advanced Weather Spotter Class sometime in the spring of 2010.

SARC Repeater:

We STILL need a climber to check the repeater feedline / antenna. Bob – W5RE has the duplexers. Pat sent an email to Steve – KE4VGB asking about doing the climb. No response.

Tim made motion during the September meeting for the club to purchase a full climbing harness to be used by club members. Costs will be limited to \$125. Bob – KI4RWL was asked if he would look at what was available. Bob will look at what is available.

NOARC Repeater:

Jim – N4NID and Cal worked on the duplexers on the 147.36 machine. They are using a 2-antenna system on the repeater.

NEW BUSINESS:

SARC Fall Picnic – The group decided to have a Club picnic on October 3rd at Open Pond Camping Area. Everyone had a good time.

Nominating Committee:

Those chosen to this committee were Bob Sullivan – W5RE, Debra Brown – KF4BOR, and John Brown – KE4HIE.
